

MINUTES OF THE  
MAY 7, 2015 BUDGET HEARING  
OF THE ROAD DISTRICT OF SUGAR GROVE  
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

**PUBLIC HEARING OPENING:** Supervisor opened the public hearing at 6:47PM.

**ROLL CALL** was taken. Present were: Supervisor Tom Rowe, Clerk Phil Silagi, Trustees Lee Drendel, Laurene Geary, Scott Hester, and Mike Fagel, and Doug Musser representing the Road District.

**BUDGET & APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #2015-2 FOR THE SUGAR GROVE TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT:** Supervisor Rowe asked for comments regarding Ordinance #2015-2 appropriating for all road purposes of Sugar Grove Township Road District, Kane County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2015 and ending March 31, 2016. The Ordinance reflects appropriations of \$58,490 in the General Road Fund, \$880,450 in the Permanent Road Fund, \$130,000 in Motor Fuel Tax, and Payroll Service Fee \$210 with total appropriations of \$1,069,150. Doug Musser noted that overlays were the major projects and expenditures for the year. Hardin Paving was the successful bidder for the overlays at \$310,000 which will consist of W. Prairie, McCannon, E. Prairie, and South Barnes. Trustee Geary offered to post on Facebook a schedule of delays, closures, and detours for construction when that information is available. Trustee Fagel asked Doug who was going to fix the Hanks Rd. Bridge over Rte.56. Doug responded that the Village was responsible and Supervisor Rowe responded that some repairs were already done. Trustee Geary noted that the Village is the owner since they annexed that area. After discussion Supervisor Rowe asked for a motion to approve Budget & Appropriation Ordinance #2015-2 for the Sugar Grove Township Road District which was made by Trustee Fagel and seconded by Trustee Geary. Trustees Drendel, Geary, Fagel, and Hester and Supervisor Rowe voted aye. 0 nays. Motion carried

**CLOSE PUBLIC HEARING:** Trustee Drendel motioned, seconded by Trustee Hester to close the Public Hearing Trustees Drendel, Geary, Fagel, and Hester, and Supervisor Rowe voted aye. 0 nays. The public hearing closed at 6:57PM.
