- **PUBLIC HEARING OPENING:** Supervisor opened the public hearing at 6:04PM.
- **ROLL CALL** was taken. Present were: Supervisor Tom Rowe, Clerk Phil Silagi, Trustees James Baker, Lee Drendel, Jerry Elliott, and Alison Squires, Assessor Curt Karas and Representing the Road District Doug Musser.
- BUDGET & APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #2017-1 FOR THE SUGAR GROVE TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT: Supervisor Rowe asked for comments regarding Ordinance #2018-1 appropriating for all road purposes of Sugar Grove Township Road District, Kane County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2018 and ending March 31, 2019. The Ordinance reflects appropriations of \$62,391 in the General Road Fund, \$935,648 in the Permanent Road Fund, \$130,000 in Motor Fuel Tax, and Payroll Service Fee \$228 with total appropriations of \$1,128,267. After review Supervisor Rowe asked for a motion to approve Budget & Appropriation Ordinance #2018-1 for the Sugar Grove Township Road District which was made by Trustee Squires and seconded by Trustee Drendel.
