

MINUTES OF THE
MAY 7, 2019 BUDGET HEARING
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SUGAR GROVE
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Tom Rowe called the meeting to order at 6:11PM.

ROLL CALL was taken. Present were: Supervisor Tom Rowe, Clerk Phil Silagi, Trustees James Baker, Lee Drendel, and Alison Squires, and Road Commissioner Doug Musser.

BUDGET & APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE SUGAR GROVE TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No. 2019-2: Supervisor Rowe opened the hearing by stating that the budget as presented is unchanged from what was discussed at the April Regular Meeting which is \$309,799 budgeted for the Township, \$254,086 for the Assessor's Office, and a Payroll Service Fee of \$550. The budget for the General Assistance Fund is \$767, and the Mental Health Fund budget is \$118,264, for Total Appropriations of \$683,466. There was no other discussion. Final adoption of the ordinance will take place during the regular township meeting following the public hearing.

ADJOURNMENT: Supervisor Rowe asked for a motion to close the Township Budget Public Hearing. Trustee Squires motioned, and Trustee Drendel seconded a motion to close the Public Hearing. Trustees Baker, Drendel, and Squires, and Supervisor Rowe voted aye. 0 nays. The Public Hearing was closed at 6:15PM.
