

MINUTES OF THE
MARCH 3, 2020 BUDGET AMENDMENT HEARING
FOR ORDINANCE #2020-1
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SUGAR GROVE
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

PUBLIC HEARING OPENING: Supervisor opened the public hearing at 6:00PM.

ROLL CALL was taken. Present were: Supervisor Tom Rowe, Clerk Phil Silagi, Trustees James Baker, Marion Bond, Jerry Elliott, and Alison Squires.

BUDGET AMENDMENT ORDINANCE #2020-1 FOR SUGAR GROVE TOWNSHIP: Supervisor Rowe explained the purpose of amendment was to increase funds in the senior transportation line item from \$48,000 to \$78,000 to cover expenses for January, February, and March. Money for this increase to come from operating funds. The Ordinance was available for public inspection for 30 days with no comment and since there are no public present and no questions or comments from the Board, Supervisor Rowe called for a motion to close the Public Hearing.
