

MINUTES OF THE
MAY 4, 2021 BUDGET HEARING
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SUGAR GROVE
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Tom Rowe called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

ROLL CALL was taken. Present were: Supervisor Tom Rowe, Clerk Phil Silagi, Trustees James Baker, Jon Bobbe, Marion Bond, and Jerry Elliott, Road Commissioner Doug Musser, and Assessor Curt Karas.

BUDGET & APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE SUGAR GROVE TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No. 2021-1: Supervisor Rowe opened the hearing by stating that the budget as presented is unchanged from what was discussed at the April Regular Meeting which is \$343,562 budgeted for the Township, \$274,326 for the Assessor's Office, and a Payroll Service Fee of \$525. The budget for the General Assistance Fund is \$814, and the Mental Health Fund budget is \$126,162, for Total Appropriations of \$745,389. There was no discussion.

ADJOURNMENT: Supervisor Rowe asked for a motion to close the Township Budget Public Hearing. Trustee Bond motioned, and Trustee Baker seconded a motion to close the Public Hearing. Trustees Baker, Bobbe, Bond and Elliott, and Supervisor Rowe voted aye. 0 nays. The Public Hearing was closed at 6:06PM.
