

MINUTES OF THE
MAY 3, 2022 BUDGET HEARING
OF THE ROAD DISTRICT OF SUGAR GROVE
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

PUBLIC HEARING OPENING: Supervisor Rowe opened the public hearing at 6:16PM.

ROLL CALL was taken. Present were: Supervisor Tom Rowe, Clerk Phil Silagi, Trustees Jon Bobbe, Marion Bond, Jerry Elliott, and Lewis Medina, Road District Commissioner Doug Musser, and Assessor Curt Karas.

ALSO PRESENT: Bill Collins

BUDGET & APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #2022-2 FOR THE SUGAR GROVE TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT: Supervisor Rowe stated that the budget is as approved in the tentative budget with minor adjustments. Supervisor Rowe asked for comments regarding Ordinance #2022-2 appropriating for all road purposes of Sugar Grove Township Road District, Kane County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2022 and ending March 31, 2023. The Ordinance reflects appropriations of \$93,918 in the General Road Fund, \$1,429,461 in the Permanent Road Fund, \$0.00 in Motor Fuel Tax, \$66,000 in the Rebuild Illinois Funds, and a Payroll Service Fee of \$250 with total appropriations of \$1,589,629. After discussion Supervisor Rowe asked for a motion to approve Budget & Appropriation Ordinance #2022-2 for the Sugar Grove Township Road District which was made by Trustee Elliott and seconded by Trustee Medina. Trustees Bobbe, Bond, Elliott, and Medina, and Supervisor Rowe voted aye. 0 nays. Motion carried.

CLOSE PUBLIC HEARING: Trustee Bobbe motioned, Trustee Elliott seconded the motion, and the Board unanimously approved adjourning the Road District Public Hearing at 6:22pm.
