

MINUTES OF THE
MAY 3 2022 BUDGET HEARING
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SUGAR GROVE
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Tom Rowe called the meeting to order at 6:01PM.

ROLL CALL was taken. Present were: Supervisor Tom Rowe, Clerk Phil Silagi, Trustees Jon Bobbe, Marion Bond, Jerry Elliott, and Lewis Medina, Road Commissioner Doug Musser, and Assessor Curt Karas.

ALSO PRESENT:

BUDGET & APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE SUGAR GROVE TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No. 2022-1: Supervisor Rowe opened the hearing by stating that the budget as presented is unchanged from what was discussed at the April Regular Meeting with minor increases in utilities and senior mowing. Trustee Bobbe noted an increase in outside services which Rowe explained was for Swanson payroll services. Appropriations for the various funds are \$482,854 budgeted for the Township, \$288,322 for the Assessor's Office, and a Payroll Service Fee of \$550. The budget for the General Assistance Fund is \$13,700 and the Mental Health Fund budget is \$128,617, for Total Appropriations of \$914,043. There was no further discussion.

ADJOURNMENT: Supervisor Rowe asked for a motion to close the Township Budget Public Hearing. Trustee Bond motioned, and Trustee Bobbe seconded a motion to close the Public Hearing. Trustees Bobbe, Bond, Elliott, and Medina, and Supervisor Rowe voted aye. 0 nays. The Public Hearing was closed at 6:15PM.
